The Australia-Latin America Business Council Limited's will encourage members to :

- conduct all business in an honest and ethical manner;

We discourage facilitation payments as a means of doing business. We expect our business partners and Members to implement and enforce effective systems to counter bribery.

We will always report and document any breach of the law that is brought to our attention through the reporting mechanism provided by Australian authorities.
